

## 1 NAME

blaze-remove - remove a post/page from the BlazeBlogger repository

## 2 SYNOPSIS

```
blaze-remove [-fipqPV] [-b directory] id...  
blaze-remove -h | -v
```

## 3 DESCRIPTION

**blaze-remove** deletes the blog posts or pages with given *ids* from the BlazeBlogger repository.

## 4 OPTIONS

**-b, --blogdir *directory***

Specify the *directory* where the BlazeBlogger repository is placed. The default option is the current working directory.

**-p, --page, --pages**

Remove pages instead of blog posts.

**-P, --post, --posts**

Remove blog posts; this is the default option.

**-i, --interactive**

Prompt before post/page removal.

**-f, --force**

Do not prompt before post/page removal; this is the default option.

**-q, --quiet**

Avoid displaying messages that are not necessary.

**-V, --verbose**

Display all messages. This is the default option.

**-h, --help**

Display usage information and exit.

**-v, --version**

Display version information and exit.
